

Old Republic Declares Regular Fourth Quarter Cash Dividend Of 18 Cents Per Share

CHICAGO, Nov. 26, 2013 /PRNewswire/ -- The Board of Directors of **Old Republic International Corporation** (NYSE: ORI) today declared a quarterly cash dividend on the common stock of 18 cents per share. This dividend is payable December 16, 2013, to shareholders of record on December 4, 2013.

This latest dividend increase marks the 32nd consecutive year that Old Republic has boosted its cash dividend rate, and 2013 becomes the 72nd year of uninterrupted cash dividend payments.

Chicago-based Old Republic International Corporation is an insurance holding company whose subsidiaries market, underwrite and provide risk management services for a wide variety of coverages, principally in the property and liability, and title insurance fields. One of the nation's 50 largest publicly owned insurance organizations, Old Republic has consolidated assets of approximately \$16.5 billion and common shareholders' equity of \$3.7 billion, or \$14.44 per share. Its current stock market valuation is approximately \$4.5 billion, or \$17.27 per share.
